Food & Drink

Deep-dish pizza, Chicago-style hot dogs, and juicy Italian Beef sandwiches are just a few of the culinary favorites you'll find in Lisle and throughout Illinois. Along with these iconic staples, you can choose among 25 Michelin-starred restaurants in Chicago as well as plenty of other fine dining options across its western suburbs. The Windy City is home to virtually limitless nightlife options. Among them, the blues are an integral part of the city's musical heritage. Of course, no matter what type of live music you like, you're bound to find it playing somewhere.

Arts & Culture

Metra trains connect Chicago's western suburbs to some of the nation's leading cultural institutions. Among them, the Art Institute of Chicago is one of the largest museums in the United States, while the Lyric Opera of Chicago has been staging ambitious productions for more than a half-century. Stunning Auditorium Theatre hosts concerts, comedians, and theatrical productions. In the suburbs, Aurora's Paramount Theatre hosts Broadway touring shows and other events. Popular Blackberry Farm is a living history museum that has re-created pioneer life.



Sports & Recreation

Lisle and Chicago's other western suburbs have plenty to offer if you like the great outdoors. Four Lakes Ski Area is a great spot for beginners or for honing skills. The Fox River Trail runs from Aurora to Algonquin, and the nearly 1,400 acre Blackwell Forest Preserve in Warrenville is great for fishing and camping. For sports fans, Chicago is a short trip away. Baseball fans can catch the Cubs or White Sox, while football fans fill Soldier Field to see the Bears. United Center is home to the NBA's Bulls and the NHL's Blackhawks.









Family Life

Lisle is home to the renowned Morton Arboretum, which offers trails for hiking and cycling, an interactive children's garden, an outdoor maze, and extensive nature education programs for children and families. Award-winning Sea Lion Aquatic Park is a popular summer destination, while the annual Eyes to the Skies Hot Air Balloon Festival draws some 80,000 people annually. Spend a day at the Brookfield Zoo and marvel at the big cats, primates, and over 400 other species of animals spread across its more than 200 acres. You can also head into Chicago to visit the Field Museum of Natural History or to relax in Lincoln Park along Lake Michigan.
